


2019 Western Pro Bono Network Conference Travel Information


• <u>Conference Location:</u> University of Utah Health Sciences Education Building, located at 25 South 2000 East, Salt Lake City UT 84112.


• Visitor parking is available to university guesthouse guests (Circled in black) and on the visitor lots to the Health Sciences Education building outdoor (south red parking) and covered lots (East red parking).




 Salt Lake City and its surrounding areas are accessible via local transit shuttles and rail. The most convenient way to reach campus is via the rail system Red Line (northbound to University Medical). The Health Sciences Education Building is located between the two final stops of the Red line heading north: Fort Douglass Station and University Medical Station (see below). From these stops, the building is a short walk away indicated from the following maps:

o Fort Douglass:







- Airport: Salt Lake International Airport
- The airport is 8.7 miles from the University of Utah campus.
- Travel from the airport to the event venue is available via public transit or ride sharing services. The UTA green line rail travels directly from the airport to several stations in downtown Salt Lake and southward beyond.

 Heading south on the Green Line, guests can transfer at the Courthouse station to a northbound Red Line that will take them directly to University of Utah campus.



- Trains depart from each station every 15 minutes Mon-Fri and every 20 minutes Sat and Sun. Fares will vary depending on the duration of the pass purchased. For full details on times and rates, please visit www.rideuta.com.
- Some lower cost airlines provide services to Ogden and Provo Regional airports, which are a considerable further distance from the University of Utah campus. For commuter services from these locations, we suggest visiting www.rideuta.com and use the trip planner feature to plot your trip from these locations.

- <u>Lodging Options</u>: The most convenient places to stay would be the two
 hotels on campus: **The University Guesthouse**, located a short walk away
 from the Education Building, or **The Marriott Hotel** at research park,
 which provides a shuttle service that can transport you on campus.

 to the rail system. Rates will vary at each location and depending on
